Ronald McDonald House Charities® of New Mexico provides a temporary residential facility for the immediate families of seriously ill children undergoing medical treatment at an Albuquerque health care facility. It provides a warm and comfortable, home-like environment for families where they can relax and share their thoughts and concerns with other people who are confronting similar problems. In addition, the nominal nightly suggested donation helps to ease the financial burden.

Since 1982, Ronald McDonald House Charities of New Mexico has provided unduplicated services to families with ill children from traditionally underserved rural populations. Every year hundreds of families in crisis find temporary lodging in the House That Love Built.

Services Available:

- 30 private bedrooms
- Four handicap accessible rooms
- Fully equipped kitchen
- Large family/dining room
- TV/living room with DVD
- Three quiet rooms
- Inside/outside play areas
- Three outside patios
- Laundry facilities
- Bed linens and towels
- Telephones in each room
- TV/VCR/DVD in each bedroom

In addition, the Ronald McDonald Family Room® program provides families with a calm and positive environment in the hospital, just steps away from their child, where they can rest and recharge during a difficult situation. Since 2007, the Ronald McDonald Family Room in UNM Children’s Hospital offers parents of pediatric in-patients a place where they are able to enjoy a few minutes of relaxation and privacy. In 2013, the Ronald McDonald Family Room at Presbyterian Hospital was opened. This Family Room provides four sleeping rooms for naps and overnight accommodations and shower facilities. Our program growth will help us stay in pace with the growing medical needs that are facing families.

Admission Policy

- Your child must be 21 years or younger and receiving daily medical treatment at one of the area hospitals or clinics.
- You must live 50 miles or more away.
- Admission to the Ronald McDonald House is based on daily room availability.
- Referrals are made by social workers. Reservations are not taken.
- Check-In Times: Mon – Sun: 9:00 am – 9:00 pm
- Check-Out Time: 1:00 pm

House Policies

The Ronald McDonald House is a home, not a motel. To encourage your child’s recovery and to provide a healthy, pleasant environment for all our guests:

- Smoking is permitted in designated areas only.
- Alcohol is not permitted.
- Room occupancy is limited and based on the size of the room available with the maximum being five people.
- Families clean their own bedroom, bathroom and make their own beds.
- Families have the ability to prepare their own meals.
- Children may not be left in the House unattended.

Nightly Fee

A nominal donation of \$15 a night per room is suggested to help meet the operating expenses of the House. No one is ever turned away for inability to pay. A \$5 key deposit is collected at check-in and is returned to you when the check-out procedure is completed.
